“Visit to Trader. Information provided by Caerphilly TS that business had an advertising board in the window claiming to be a charity. (Photograph taken) Poster was displayed in the small wind located in the ally way to the indoor market which states "charity". Spoke to a young lady in the shop and I requested that the poster is removed. I also had concerns about the amount of stock in the shop. You could not access the room facing commercial street as the room was waist high with goods with no way of accessing the exit. Reported to EH as concerns from a H&S perspective. Requested that the sign is removed”.

“Compliant on First Inspection- Small charity shop. food bank. Distributes food supplied by the Trussell Trust to people with food bank vouchers. Small selection of pre packed long life food available. Nothing refrigerated or with use by dates. Staff are currently undergoing H&S and FH training. Does provide free teas and coffees

for staff and customers, but is not pushing this at the moment as they do not have room in the shop for people to sit down.

Only provides dairy milk for this, is not catering for allergies.

All items for food bank in date”.

Intelligence received (late afternoon on 21/02/2024) from Caerphilly CBC Trading Standards concerning the (FSA) Reckitt infant formula product recall due to the presence of Cronobacter sakazakii in batches of Nutramigen LGG infant formula.

The CCBC intelligence was that the products affected were being supplied by the charity business trading as Jayne's Mother and Baby Milk & Charity Shop, 5 Crane Street, Pontypool.

Visit to Jayne's Mother & Baby Milk & Charity Shop was undertaken on 23/02/2024.

The shop was only supplying 6 packages of the Nutraigen LGG infant formula. Batch codes from all 6 products checked, and none were of the batches affected as detailed in

the FSA product recall information.

As such, FBO was given advice that the 6 packages at the Pontypool site are safe to be supplied.
